Novato Walkers—at Rush Creek Preserve

Thursday, December 2, 9:30 – 10:30am, weather permitting

Rush Creek Preserve, Binford Rd., Novato

The walk will take place at **Rush Creek Preserve**, a location we've enjoyed several times. From Hwy 101 in Novato, take exit 463 for Atherton Ave east. Turn left onto Binford Rd. The gate is on the right. There is usually ample parking along Binford Road.

There are some gravel patches on the mostly level trail. If you have walking sticks, you are welcome to bring them, but they are not required. This easygoing trail follows along rich tidal wetlands. The broad, level Pinheiro Fire Road is popular with hikers, bikers, and equestrians. It offers unimpeded views of a large wetland managed by the California Department of Fish and Game. From the eastern end of the 522-acre preserve, you can look out across the Petaluma River delta to Sonoma County and beyond.
