



One of our steering committee members just read *The Invisible Life of Addie LaRue* by V.E. Schwab and very much enjoyed reading this thrilling fictional novel that follows Addie LaRue through centuries. The hardest thing about reading this book was having no more pages to read at the end!

Summary: France, 1714: in a moment of desperation, a young woman makes a Faustian bargain to live forever—and is cursed to be forgotten by everyone she meets. Thus begins the extraordinary life of Addie LaRue, and a dazzling adventure that will play out across centuries and continents, across history and art, as a young woman learns how far she will go to leave her mark on the world.
